### **Performance Criteria**

Firefighter is able to articulate various considerations when establishing a cutting station for shoring operations.

Firefighter is proficient in the use of the various tools and equipment needed for establishing a cutting station.

Firefighter is competent in the various roles associated with the cutting station operation.

### **Time Parameters**

Safe and efficient manner -20 minutes or less

### **Safety Precautions**

Space allocation to prevent injury to self or others while operating Appropriate PPE Attention to surroundings

### Procedure

✓ Firefighter establishes the Cut Station with the following parameters in mind:

### **Cut Station Team Positions**

Cutter - 1	Runner - 1
Feeder - 2	Layout Person - 1

✓ Firefighter identifies the roles of the Cut Station as follows:

Cutter – Operates the saws for cutting material

**Feeder** – Assists the cutter in holding the lumber in place for the necessary cuts needed of the lumber

**Runner** – Takes cut material to the operations scene and brings back additional lists for additional cut material

**Layout Person** – Responsible for setting up the cut station area. Manages the flow of material to the cut station and pulls the anticipated lumber supplies from the storage cache

✓ Firefighter identifies the equipment elements needed for the cut station as follows:

4' x 8' Template Board & Saw Horses	Tool Belts
Tape Measures, Pencils, Speed Squares, etc.	Assorted Hand Tools
10 ¼ inch Circular Saw	7 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> inch Circular Saw
Access to Chain Saws	Access to K-12 Saws
110 volt Power Supply – 20 Amp Preferred	Extension Cords
Laminated Shoring Job Aids	Lighting for Night Operations

✓ Firefighter establishes a safe and organized cut station for either day or night operations.
