Firefighter is able to don complete structural PPE ensemble. Firefighter is able to be prepared to enter hazard area, less SCBA. Firefighter is able to recognize defective gear and remove from service if deemed necessary.

Time Parameters

60 seconds or less

Safety Precautions

Space allocation to prevent injury to self or others while donning

Procedure

Simulating a response, the firefighter will don a complete set of structural turnout gear. All components will be properly worn, all fasteners closed, hood on, helmet on with chinstrap in place and gloves on. Once the donning takes place, the firefighter shall raise hand to indicate the task or competency is complete.
